This Week's Topic:

Reclaimed Water Available

Since Thursday, March 1, 2018, the City of Las Vegas has allowed the public to obtain water from the reclaimed water stand pipe at the Utility Service Center located at 905 12th Street. Hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The cost of the water is \$1.25 per 1000 gallons and an additional \$.50 charge per trip. New customers that want to get reclaimed water must stop by the Utility Services Center to sign a usage agreement and set up an account. Existing customers must also stop by the Center to sign an updated 2018 usage agreement. Customers will not be able to get water until a signed agreement is on file.

Re-selling of reclaimed waste water is strictly prohibited
