This Week's Topic:

Reuse of Reclaimed Treated Water

The City of Las Vegas recently submitted an application to New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) to renew and modify the discharge of reclaimed domestic Wastewater from the City of Las Vegas Wastewater Treatment Plant to a reuse system of up to 1,056,290 gallons per day (gpd). The modification will allow for the beneficial reuse of reclaimed wastewater for irrigation at the Calle Alegre Housing Development. This application will also allow for the discharge of reclaimed domestic wastewater to irrigate our local public parks. A public notice is posted at public parks being irrigated with treated effluent water from the City of Las Vegas Wastewater Treatment Plant.
