This Week's Topic:

Solid Waste Improvements

The City of Las Vegas Solid Waste and Project Management Departments met with an Engineering Firm in early April to plan improvements to the Solid Waste Transfer Station. Souder, Miller & Associates (SMA) was contracted by the City of Las Vegas to prepare a Planning Report to address operational upgrades to the City of Las Vegas Solid Waste Transfer Station (SWTS). SMA staff conducted a site visit in January 2017 to review operational procedures, observe facility operations and conditions, and interview SWTS staff. Based on the site visit and staff interviews, SMA has prepared a list of individual upgrades and modifications. The Facility modifications have been grouped into three categories: 1) tasks to provide immediate necessary maintenance, repairs and upgrades to improve safety, regulatory compliance and operational efficiency; 2) tasks to provide improvements for general safety and operational efficiency; and 3) longer-term operational improvements.
