This Week's Topic:

Storrie Lake Line Leak Repair

Hays Plumbing has begun to repair 200 feet of 16 inch Concrete Pipe Cylinder (CPC) Waterline across Storrie Canal. The CPC Water Line runs from our Water treatment Plant to NM 250. This water line is also known as the Medite Water Line. This project will include slip lining the existing 16 inch water main which will eliminate digging thru Storrie Canal. The City discovered the leak 3 years ago. The CPC water line has been leaking approximately 100gpm. The City's Engineer recently developed a plan to make repairs to the CPC water line which would allow for the repair with limited impact to water users or Storrie Canal. The CPC Waterline is very difficult to make repairs to because the metal pipe is encased with concrete.
