## PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

May 15, 2020

4:00 p.m.

City of Las Vegas offices and facilities will have a limited reopening on Monday, May 18, 2020. The opening will be subject to the State's public health restrictions, which among things limit the number of people allowed in various establishments, promote social distancing and require the wearing of masks in public. The public is encouraged to contact City Offices before visiting.

Exceptions and modifications to the opening of city offices include:

1. The Abe Montoya Recreation Center, like all gyms in the state, will remain closed until further notice.
2. Senior Center facilities will remain closed until further notice for congregate visits. However, the Senior Center program will continue to provide meals to seniors in a Drive-Up/Drive-through setting. They also will respond to requests for temporary Home Delivery.
3. The Municipal Court will remain closed for in-person visits until further notice. However, the court will continue to provide services by phone and email.
4. City hall offices will be open subject to public health restrictions.
5. City Council chambers will be open for City Council meetings, but access will be limited due to space constraints. Individuals also may provide input to the council by emailing them to the City Clerk or by providing written comments....Council meetings are available to the public on TV, Comcast channel xxx and on YouTube.
6. The City Utility Customer Service Office will continue to provide services by phone and email next week. The office is working towards being completely open the following week, or shortly thereafter.
7. The City Solid Waste Transfer station will continue with its current hours of operations, balancing the needs of contractors and residents. They expect that they will be able to return to being open during their regular business hours soon.
