PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW RESCISSION

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas (“City”) led the State of New Mexico in moving from the “Red” level (very high risk) to the “Yellow” level (high risk) of the New Mexico Department of Health’s Covid-19 risk assessment framework, and the hard work and community cooperation of the City’s residents and visitors has now resulted in the City achieving the “Green” level (medium risk); and

WHEREAS, based on the current data related to Covid-19, input from health professionals and the public, the Mayor has determined the curfew resulting from the Proclamation of Civil Emergency is no longer necessary at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the public health, safety and welfare of the City’s residents and visitors to rescind the curfew resulting from the Proclamation of Civil Emergency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the duly elected and sworn Mayor of the City of Las Vegas this 7th day of April, 2021, the curfew resulting from the Proclamation of Civil Emergency is hereby rescinded. The Mayor, on behalf of the City, thanks the City’s residents and visitors for their continued vigilance regarding Covid-19 and their help in improving the City through community cooperation.
