Applications are being accepted for a full time temp **Water Supervisor** for the City of Las Vegas Water Department.

Entry Level: \$14.61

Nature of Job: Supervision over Distribution System Maintenance Crews from Water Equipment Operator to Labor. The Water Foreman will plan, organize, direct, supervise, and participate in projects relating to the operation, maintenance, and construction of the City's Water System under the direction of the Water Distribution Field Superintendent. Any project, deemed necessary by the Water Distribution Superintendent, will be accomplished when scheduled for by the Crew Leader and a maintenance crew. The Water Distribution Superintendent will determine what equipment and supplies are needed along with the required manpower to accomplish any given task. He/She will be called upon to make water taps of all sizes and all other activities involved in water line installations and maintenance. Calls in the locations for jobs and water leaks. Occasionally meets with customers. Does measurements for Blue Cards. Other duties as assigned. (A detailed job description is available at the Human Resource Office.)

Qualifications: High School Diploma or Equivalent. Valid New Mexico Class D drivers license, with good driving record. Must be insurable by City's insurance carrier. Must possess or obtain CDL Class B license within 6 months of employment. Requires driving of dump trucks, loader, backhoe, service vehicles. Must possess a New Mexico Water Systems Level II Certification or six years experience in water utility field. Must have ten (10) credits per year from the New Mexico Water Association. Prefer at least six (6) years experience in the water utility field or Level II Certification. Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing. Ability to perform heavy manual work. Ability to plan and direct various departmental activities.
