This Week's Topic:

The CDC states on its website that the COVID-19 virus is thought to spread mainly from person to person. Specifically, [OSHA states](#) that without sustained human-to-human transmission, most American workers are not at significant risk of infection. As a result, the City of Las Vegas Utilities Department is adjusting operations that can affect employees and customers. We are following the recommendations from the CDC to minimize contact with each other by keeping a six (6) foot separation. Should the COVID-19 situation worsens, Utilities Department will reassess the situation. If it is determined necessary we may need to restrict public access to all of our facilities. Solid Waste services will continue according to schedule. Bill payment is available through the mail, over the phone, in the drop box, and online at www.lasvegasnm.gov. Water and waste water treatment will not be impacted as this is an essential service. Gas and Water repairs and service installations will continue as needed with essential services being prioritized. We will continue providing updates to the public through local media as well as on our website lasvegasnm.gov and through social media.
