Polydyne Clarifloc C-358, a polymer added to water during the drinking water treatment process.

- IV. Provide an explanation of the criteria developed and specified by the agency as necessary to perform and/or fulfill the contract and upon which the state agency reviewed available sources. (Do not use “technical jargon;” use plain English. Do not tailor the criteria simply to exclude other contractors if it is not rationally related to the purpose of the contract.)

The criteria to use Clarifloc C-358 was identified by lab comparison when first prescribed by Molzen Corbin engineering in 1996. The criteria were later confirmed by laboratory comparison by HDR engineering in 2015.

Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of the reasons, qualifications, proprietary rights or unique capabilities of the prospective contractor that makes the prospective contractor ***the one source capable*** of providing the required professional service, service, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property. Clarifloc C-358 was tested by engineering prior to its initial use when the clarification structure was built in 1996. The product was compared against other similar products by different makers and determined to be the best fit for the City’s treatment process in terms of efficacy. C-358 is a proprietary liquid polymer chemical blend that is only made by the Polydyne company. The effectiveness of C-358 was again tested by engineering in 2015, with the same results.

- VI. Provide a detailed sufficient explanation of how the professional service, service, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property *is/are unique and how this uniqueness is substantially related to the intended purpose of the contract.*

Clarifloc C-358 is a proprietary blend chemicals that is only produced by Polydyne. The City has put this product out to bid every year since 1996. The bid has always been awarded to Polydyne, as they are the only manufacturer of C-358.

- VII. Explain why other similar professional services, services, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property *cannot* meet the intended purpose of the contract.

Clarifloc C-358 was tested by engineering prior to its initial use when the clarification structure was built in 1996. The product was compared against other similar products by different makers and determined to be the best fit for the City's treatment process in terms of efficacy. C-358 is a proprietary liquid polymer chemical blend that is only made by the Polydyne company. The effectiveness of C-358 was again tested by engineering in 2015, with the same results.

- VIII. Provide a narrative description of the agency's due diligence in determining the basis for the procurement, including procedures used by the agency to conduct a review of available sources such as researching trade publications, industry newsletters and the internet; reviewing telephone books and other advertisements; contacting similar services providers; and reviewing the State Purchasing Agent's vendor list.
