CITY OF LAS VEGAS SIGN REQUIREMENTS

HEIGHT LIMITATIONS OF SIGNS

- (A.) ALL SIGNS SHALL NOT BE HIGHER THAN 20' (FEET), UNLESS OWNER GOES THROUGH VARIANCE FOR APPROVAL.**
- (B.) ALL FREE-STANDING SIGNS SHALL HAVE A LIMITATION OF 100 SQUARE FEET IN SIZE,**
- (C.) ALL SIGNS ATTACHED TO BUILDING SHALL HAVE A LIMITATION OF 500 SQUARE FEET.**

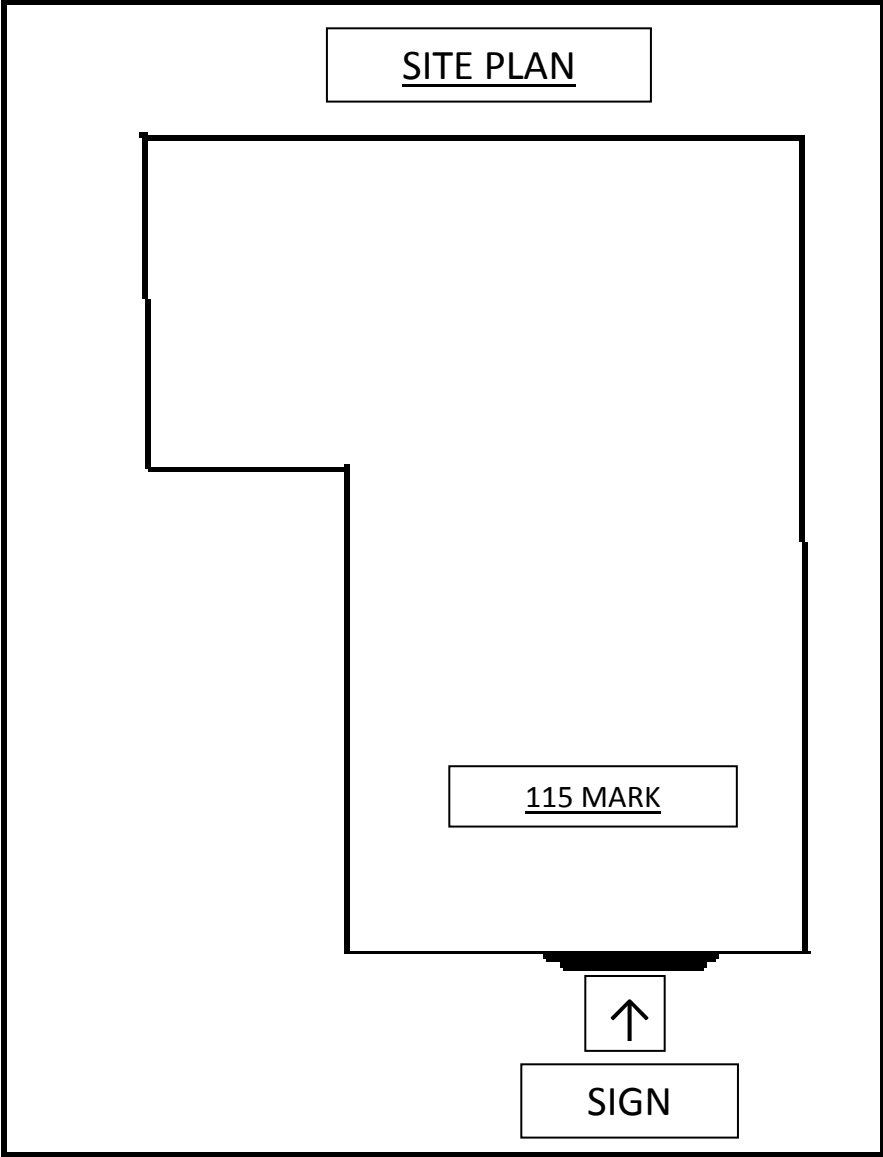
PLANS REQUIRED FOR PLACEMENT OF SIGN

- 1.) SITE PLAN – A birds eye view drawing or a survey showing all building, streets, alleys, and an arrow showing where sign will be placed on the site.
- 2.) A drawing of the sign (how the sign will look), with the size of the sign and material used for sign.
- 3.) Height of sign from the ground up. If the sign will be in the ground then you will need a footing plan (how deep, how wide concrete will go into ground).
- 4.) Explain on plan how sign will be attached to building or poles, such as what size of screws, nails, etc. will be used.
