

SKATE PARK HOURS:

Summer hours (April 1st – October 31st) : 6am TO SUNSET

Winter hours (November 1st – March 30th): 11am TO SUNSET

The City of Las Vegas Recreation Center has the discretion to close the **Skate Park** due to inclement weather, wet surfaces or any other unsafe conditions at any time.

Rules for Skate Park:

The park is **UNSUPERVISED**, Skate at your own risk

No **BIKES ALLOWED**

Park is “FREE” to skate with a signed waiver release of liability form

Each individual skater needs to fill out the waiver and sign it inside the Recreation Center

The City of Las Vegas **DOES NOT** assume responsibility for injury

The use of Protective Gear as stated in “ORDINANCE” No. 02-07

Know your ability and skate accordingly

Avoid collisions

Reckless or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated

Be courteous and respectful of others. Take turns, Have fun!

Adult supervision is strongly recommended for children under the age of 12

Horseplay, shoving, and/or fighting will not be tolerated

Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances is strictly prohibited

NO SMOKING is allowed in the skate park

NO food, beverages or glass containers allowed in skate area

NO spectators or pets on skating surfaces

NO modifications to the skating surface or structures

DO NOT add obstacles

Graffiti, littering, and vandalism of park property is strictly prohibited and violators will be prosecuted

ORDINANCE NO: 02-07

An ordinance amending section 02-07, entitled “USE OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATV) SCOOTERS, ROLLER SKATES, SKATEBOARDS AND SIMILAR DIVICES RESTRICTED,” of the traffic regulations of the City of Las Vegas, New Mexico.

Be it ordained by the City of Las Vegas, the Governing body of the City of Las Vegas, New Mexico , that

Section 16-3-6 shall be amended and titled “required use of helmets, of the type certified by Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)

A. Persons seventeen, (17) years of age and younger shall be required to wear certified (CPSC) helmet while they are using, riding, or operating wheeled item.

B. A “wheeled item” is defined as, but not limited to, ATV’s (all terrain vehicles), bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller-blades, skates, go carts, and cycles.

C. A citation will be issued as penalty for the first offense and will require proof of ownership of CPSC helmet and attendance at a safety presentation for their youth and legal guardian; if proof of helmet, and/or class attendance noncompliance, a twenty-five (\$25) dollar fine. A second offense will require proof of ownership of CPSC helmet and community service; if proof of helmet or community service noncompliance, a fifty (\$50) dollar fine. A third or subsequent offense will result in a seventy-five (\$75) DOLLAR FINE. The fines collected will be used to fund child safety promotion activities.
